

Some Things to Think About

Medically Speaking, Joseph and Mary Were Not the “Father” and “Mother” of JESUS

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Neither Joseph, nor Mary were physically related to JESUS. Had either of them contributed DNA to JESUS that would make them greater than GOD. They were not. Luke 1:17, 31 and 35 are examples of “specific wording” in the Bible that provide the proof of that statement.

First, notice in verse 17 that the “and he shall” refers to John, and the “before him” literally refers to JESUS who is called LORD later in that same verse via the text “to make ready a people prepared for the Lord” (KJV).

Next, notice verse 31, which also refers to JESUS. This verse reads, “And, behold, thou shalt conceive in thy womb, and bring forth a son, and shalt call his name Jesus” (KJV).

The words “conceive,” and “womb” are in the Greek. They didn’t know it back then, but GOD did: Conception does not occur in the womb. It occurs in the fallopian tube. That means that neither the male sperm, nor the female egg, contributed to the physical body of JESUS, the last Adam, because we are specifically told in the verse that Mary conceived in her womb. Note that the word “womb” could have been left out of the text, but GOD had the writer put it in when from their limited perspective back then, there was no need to add the “extra” word because, again from their limited perspective, where else would conception occur(?). I use the word “extra” because what we think of as paper today was too expensive back then to waste by adding “extra” words into the text.

The KJV doesn’t seem to know how to parse verse 35, but I agree with how they did it, because, how else could they explain the Greek? In reference to JESUS, the KJV reads, “therefore also that holy thing which shall be born of thee shall be called the Son of God.” Notice the word “thing.” The Greek reads, “and therefore the being born holy will be called Son of God.” Holy means “set apart by/for GOD.” What’s missing from this verse is any word similar to infant, unborn child, newborn, or, simply the word for child. Yet, like Adam, JESUS was fully human. They could touch and hold him, and drive nails through his hands.

Therefore, in my best [Maury Povich](#) voice, medically speaking, Joseph and Mary WERE NOT the “father” and “mother” of JESUS, GOD.
